

## Requirements and Ideas for Nephite Apparel for Moroni's Quest



All participants – youth, tribe leaders, camp directors, bishops, and any others who visit the camp – should dress in Book of Mormon-type clothing at all times. Each person attending the event will need two outfits and a satchel. Clothing should be simple and inexpensive. Be resourceful. Where possible, use or re-use items you already have.

Parents and youth are responsible to create their own costumes. Where possible, create them together as a family.

### Clothing outfits

- **Tunics:** Tunics should be 2-3 inches below the knee, have a capped sleeve or longer and be a tunic, dress, or shirt/skirt combo (YM included)
  - Make tunics large enough to be worn over regular clothing (t-shirts, knee-length shorts or pants) and loose enough to allow for movement
  - It's going to be hot weather ... make clothing out of materials that will be breathable and as lightweight as possible
    - Choose earth tone colors & patterns that are true to the Book of Mormon time period; no bright neons
    - Visit a store (like Deseret Industries) to:
      - Buy scrub top, then add trims/tassels, then use fabric for a wrap at waist
      - Buy twin sheet/inexpensive light weight fabric to make a tunic then add trims



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- **Shoes:** Two pairs of comfortable closed toe shoes. No sandals or flip-flops.
- **Knee length shorts:** Shorts should be worn under all Nephite attire at all times. Bring at least two pairs of shorts.
- **T-Shirts:** T-Shirts should be worn under tunics or other types of tops that are open on the sides or neckline (bring at least 2 t-shirts). No short shorts, tank tops, or camis please.
- **Satchel:** Approximately 10 x 12 inches with over-the-shoulder strap.



- **Head gear:** Head gear including hats, scarves, etc. are allowed and strongly encouraged to protect you from the sun.
- **Embellishments:** Headbands, armbands, ankle and calf ornaments, belts, drapes, vests, shoulder shawls, collars, and jewelry can all be added to make your apparel unique. Hint: Do NOT glue items to leather or imitation leather (the glue won't adhere properly and once it is on, it is very difficult to sew through)
- **Restrictions:** No camis/tank tops, short shorts, flip flops, open toed shoes, personal jewelry, modern fabrics (e.g. pink leopard, floral prints, camo, etc.), skin or face painting or temporary tattoos.
