GENERAL INFORMATION

Reflections

- Bishops in charge of night time reflections – Wed, Thurs, and Friday.
- Ward is responsible for reflections for adults after each reenactment – Bishops need to assign
- Spiritual Reflections Manual has been created to aid in leading the reflections (*See SPIRITUAL REFLECTION MANUAL*)

Tribe Leaders & Tribe Assignments

- 56 Tribes
- 12 Youth per tribe
- Variety of wards and ages in each tribe
- If you have any youth with special needs please contact Chris & Lynnae Jensen of Greenfield Acres Ward

Transportation

- Very limited parking – everyone will park at Heber ward building and shuttled to site
- Asking for everyone to carpool
- Gas will only be reimbursed with pre-approval

SCHEDULE

Saturday – June 3rd

- All youth, YM/YW Leaders and tribe leaders drop off their garbage sack of gear on Sat June 3rd to their ward Location
- (*See CAMPING GEAR DROP OFF & PICK UP LOCATIONS*)
- YM/YW Leaders will NOT need tents – two large tents will be provided per ward. One tent for YM and one for YW located on opposite ends of the camp. YM/YW Leaders will be staying in tent with their youth.
- Bishopric Members can either stay in large tent with their ward young men or bring tent

Monday – June 5th

- Set up Committee taking all gear to Camp Heber

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Wednesday – June 7th

- 6:00 am Stake Leaders arrive at Higley Center for Preforming Arts
- 6:30 am YM/YW Leaders and Tribe Leaders arrive
- Please arrive in Nephite attire with satchel, water bottle and sack lunch
- 7:00 am Meeting for all YM & YW Leaders begins promptly at 7:00
- Ward YM/YW Leaders will be checking in the youth of their ward - instructions will be given at the morning meeting
 - Each youth will receive a lanyard which will identify their tribe and their seat assignment in the auditorium
 - Youth will be seated by tribe and YM & YW Leaders will help youth find their seats
- 7:45 am Bishopric members arrive - for parking instructions **(See HIGLEY ART CENTER DROP OFF LOCATION)**
- 8:00 am Youth Arrive
- 8:30 am All youth and leaders seated in auditorium
- 9:00 am First Reenactment begins **ACT 1: Nephi and Liahona** (broadcasted on Facebook Live)
- 10:00 am Depart for Camp Heber
- Stake Leaders, Bishoprics, YM & YW Leaders will be dismissed first from auditorium and should drive directly to Camp Heber and drop off all passengers and gear. No onsite parking – cars will be parked at LDS church in Heber or at the school **(See HEBER PARKING LOCATIONS)**
 - Shuttle will pick up drivers from parking locations and bring them back to Camp Heber
- 2:00 pm Buses arrive NEAR Camp Heber - youth and tribe leaders hike (approx. 1 mile) to Nephi's Ship
- All Stake, Bishoprics and Ward YM & YW Leaders should be gathered at Nephi's ship when youth arrive
 - Reenactment will take place in two separate groups
 - No adult reflection to take place with Nephi's ship reenactment. Bishoprics and Ward YM & YW Leaders to help youth locate their ward's tent and their gear and help them get settled into camp-when they return from tribe reflection.
- 3:00 pm Ward time and camp set up
- 5:30 pm Group A Dinner – (Chandler Heights, Centennial, San Tan Park, Shamrock Farms, Seville Park)
- 6:00 pm Group B Dinner – (Country Shadows, Greenfield Acres, Seville, Seville Groves)
- Youth and adults will eat meals as wards – NOT as tribes – Ward Leaders responsible for youth
 - Lanyards will identify your ward as "A" or "B" meal group – this will not change
 - Wards to provide adults to help serve the food **(See FOOD SERVING SCHEDULE)**
- 6:30 pm Ward free time
- Have youth take chairs from Tribe Leader reflection area and take to ward reflection area **(See WARD REFLECTION AREA MAP)**
- 8:00 pm Wards head to Amphitheatre (Will need jacket or sweater, water, Book of Mormon and flashlight)
- Music will sound signifying its time to take ward youth to amphitheater
 - Youth will be together as wards and reflect after the reenactment as wards
- 8:30 pm **ACT 3: Tree of Life Reenactment**
- Bishop and ward leaders receive their youth at tree of life and then lead them to ward reflection areas.
 - Bishop leads reflections in Ward Reflection area with their entire ward including all of the youth.
- 10:00 pm Ready for Bed
- 10:30 pm Lights out
- All Ward YM & YW Leaders will stay in the large tents with youth

8:30 am	Play music – All youth to join their tribe - Tribe Leaders will be lined up 1-55 outside of amphitheater <ul style="list-style-type: none">Youth take their camping chair to Tribe Leader Reflection area
9:00 am	ACT 4: The Separation. Watch reenactment then receive instructions regarding battle. Will divide amphitheater into ½ Lamanites and ½ Nephites. Head to field and get swords and shields. Lamanites on one side Nephites on the other. Horn ends battle. All youth go to tribe reflection. Ward Leaders to attend ward adult reflections. Music will signal time to return to amphitheater
10:00 am	ACT 5: Enos. Adults to Ward reflections and youth to tribe reflections. Music will signal time to return
11:00 am	ACT 6: King Benjamin. Adults to Ward reflections and youth to tribe reflections. Music will signal time to return
12:00 pm	Group A Lunch
12:30 pm	Group B Lunch
1:00 pm	VILLAGE AND GAMES –All Ward Leaders will be assigned a time to help at Village and Games (See VILLAGE & GAMES ASSIGNMENTS) <ul style="list-style-type: none">Youth will not be required to stay with their tribes or wards during these activities

8:00 pm	Wards head to Amphitheatre (Will need jacket or sweater, water, Book of Mormon and flashlight) <ul style="list-style-type: none">Music will sound signifying its time to take ward youth to amphitheaterYouth will be together as wards and reflect after the reenactment as wards
8:30 pm	ACT 7: Abinadi. Following reenactment separate to ward areas for bishop reflections.

8:30 am	Music played – reunite with tribe and be seated in amphitheater (get chair to tribe area prior to reenactments) (TL report any missing youth to chief tribe leader)
9:00 am	ACT 8: Sons of Mosiah. Adults to Ward reflections and youth to tribe reflections. Music will signal time to return.
10:00 am	ACT 9: Alma and Amulek. Adults to Ward reflections and youth to tribe reflections. Music will signal time to return.
11:00 am	ACT 10: Ammon's Mission. Adults to Ward reflections and youth to tribe reflections. Music will signal time to return.
12:00 pm	Group A Lunch
12:30 pm	Group B Lunch
1:00 pm	Play music- Reunite with Tribe and return to amphitheater.
1:30 pm	ACT 11: Anti-Nephi-Lehi's. Adults to Ward reflections and youth to tribe reflections. Music will signal time to return.
2:30 pm	ACT 12: The War Chapters part 1. Adults to Ward reflections and youth to tribe reflections. Music will signal time to return.
3:30 pm	ACT 12: The War Chapters part 2. Stripling warriors brought onto stage. All youth head to battle field, get swords and shields and await stripling warriors. Stripling warriors march to field, receive swords and shields. All battle.

10:30 pm	ACT 15: Joseph Smith <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Stake presidency closing remarks – there will not be a tribe leader reflection after this reenactment
12:00 pm	Group A Lunch
12:30 pm	Group B Lunch
1:00 pm	Pack and load trailers/clean up
1:30 pm	Load Buses – Tribe leaders will ride home on buses with their tribe
2:00 pm	Anticipated departure from Camp Heber <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ward leaders can get cars and drive into camp to pick up gear once the youth have left on buses
5:30 pm	Pickup at Casteel High School (NEC of Power and Riggs) <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All youth and tribe leader gear will be brought home by the Take Down Committee later that evening (SEE CAMPING GEAR DROP OFF & PICK UP LOCATIONS)

ITEMS EACH WARD SHOULD PROVIDE FOR MORONI'S QUEST



Tents:

Tents will be provided by the stake for youth and youth leaders - there will be one large tent for each gender in distinct camping areas. Tribe leaders, bishopricks and any stake leaders will need to provide their own tents.

Suggested items for your ward camp area:

Lanterns/light of some kind

Table(s)

Five (5) one-gallon jugs of water (for brushing teeth or washing hands, etc.)

Soap/hand sanitizer

Additional snacks for youth

Optional activities for free time/ward time

Medical:

Each ward is responsible to provide two first aid kits – one for the young men camp and one for the young women camp. The following items are suggested. Please bring any additional as you see fit. Most wards likely have these supplies in their current scouting first aid kits. Please verify that the supplies have not expired.

Various adhesive bandages of different sizes

Antibiotic ointment for small cuts

Hydrocortisone ointment

Benadryl ointment

Isopropyl (rubbing) alcohol to cleanse small wounds

Sunburn ointment to treat sunburns (such as aloe gel)

Ibuprofen

Tylenol

Forceps (tweezers) to remove slivers or thorns

Moleskin or similar to treat blisters

Feminine hygiene supplies

Sunscreen

Hand sanitizing gel

Disposable medical gloves

Ace bandages

Sterile gauze rolls and pads

Antacids

Anti-diarrheal medication

Over-the-counter cold and allergy medications

Blunt tip scissors

Cloth tape for securing bandages

Chapstick or similar

Lubricating eye drops

It will also be the responsibility of each ward to administer any prescription medications. Ward leadership may want to require parental attendance for some medications and medical conditions.
